

## **Guide to CAP's 4 Application Pathways**

When completing CAP's Application for Evaluation of Academic Credentials form, applicants are required to select which application pathway they are applying through as described in Section 2 in the <u>Criteria for Evaluating Academic Credentials</u>. This worksheet was designed as a tool to support members who are completing their application with CAP. **This worksheet is intended to provide supportive information only and is not an exhaustive resource**. If you are uncertain which pathway to apply through, connect directly with CAP. Failing to select the correct Application pathway will delay the processing of your application.

Pathway	Pathway Description	Notes for Specific Pathway
Pathway 1 Regular Psychology Pathway	<ul> <li>Must have obtained a graduate degree in psychology from a Government Authorized/Accredited Institution that meets the academic criteria established by College Council for credentials evaluation</li> <li>Graduate degree MUST contain the word "Psychology" or "Psychological"</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Review Section 6 of the <u>Criteria</u> to determine whether course content fulfills CAP's requirements</li> <li>Must complete the course-by-course evaluation for core and substantive courses (see <u>PAA's Course-By-Course Evaluation Tip Sheet</u> and review Section 8 of the <u>Criteria</u>)</li> </ul>
Pathway 2 Substantial Equivalency Pathway	<ul> <li>Must have obtained a graduate degree in areas other than psychology. CAP defines a graduate degree in psychology as a degree that has the words "Psychology" or "Psychological" in its title and is intended for the purpose of training people in the profession of psychology.</li> <li>Graduate degrees or transcript does NOT contain the word "Psychology" or "Psychological"</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Review Section 7 of the <u>Criteria</u> to determine whether course content fulfills CAP's requirements</li> <li>Must complete the course-by-course evaluation for core and substantive courses (see <u>PAA's Course-By-Course Evaluation Tip Sheet</u> and Review Section 8 of the <u>Criteria</u>)</li> <li>Applicants with a doctoral degree who are <u>initially</u> applying to have their academic credentials evaluated are <b>NOT</b> required to complete a</li> </ul>

		separate evaluation for their doctoral credentials.
Pathway 3 CPA/APA Approved Doctoral Pathway	Must have obtained a Doctoral degree in a Clinical Psychology, Clinical Neuropsychology, Counselling Psychology, or School Psychology program accredited by the Canadian Psychological Association or American Psychological Association	<ul> <li>These programs must abide by strict CPA/APA accreditation requirements and therefore applicants in this pathway are EXEMPT from the process of course-by-course evaluation</li> <li>The University of Alberta's Ph.D. in School and Clinical Child Psychology is a CAP approved program and therefore graduates can apply under Pathway 4</li> <li>Applicants with a doctoral degree who are initially applying to have their academic credentials evaluated are NOT required to complete a separate evaluation for their doctoral credentials.</li> </ul>
Pathway 4 CAP Approved Programs Pathway	<ul> <li>Must have completed the following programs after the specified approval dates:         <ul> <li>Athabasca University – Master of Counselling in Counselling Psychology (February 27, 2021)</li> <li>University of Alberta – Master of Education in Counselling Psychology (February 27, 2021)</li> <li>University of Alberta – Doctor of Philosophy in School and Clinical Child Psychology *</li></ul></li></ul>	<ul> <li>Universities with CAP approved programs will provide CAP with the names of graduates who are eligible to apply through this pathway</li> <li>Applicants who completed a program before it became approved may not meet all the requirements to apply through this pathway</li> <li>Applicants through this pathway are EXEMPT from the process of course-by-course evaluation because these programs have been approved by the University Program Approval Committee</li> </ul>

- University of Lethbridge Master of Education in Counselling Psychology (February 27, 2021)
- University of Lethbridge Master of Counselling in Applied Psychology (February 27, 2021)
- University of Calgary Master of Education in School and Applied Child Psychology (December 2, 2022)
- University of Calgary Master of Science in Counselling Psychology (December 2, 2022)
- Graduates from these programs whose names are not provided to CAP by their University will need to submit course-by-course evaluation and select "Other" as their pathway
- Applicants enrolled in the University of Alberta's Ph.D. in School and Clinical Child Psychology program may be eligible to apply through Pathway 4 following completion of doctoral coursework but prior to dissertation defense. Please contact the Director of Training for your program to confirm

All applicants must have obtained their degrees from institutions which were authorized/accredited at the time coursework and related requirements were completed. Any degrees from or courses taken at educational institutions that were/are not accredited will not be accepted.
